1. GAUTENG:

Cloudy and cool.

The expected UVB sunburn index:Low

2. MPUMALANGA:

Morning drizzle and fog patches along the escarpment, otherwise cloudy and cold to cool.

3. LIMPOPO:

Morning drizzle and fog patches along the escarpment, otherwise cloudy and cool with isolated showers and thundershowers in the west and north.

4. NORTH-WEST PROVINCE:

Partly cloudy and cool with isolated showers and thundershowers in the north, clearing by the evening.

5. FREE STATE:

Morning fog patches in the east where it will be cloudy, otherwise partly cloudy and cool to warm.

6. NORTHERN CAPE:

Cloudy with morning fog along the coast where it will be cool, otherwise fine and warm to hot, but partly cloudy in the north east.

The wind along the coast will be light to moderate southerly to southerly becoming fresh to strong in the afternoon.

7. WESTERN CAPE:

Morning fog patches along coastal areas and adjacent interior where it will be partly cloudy and cool, otherwise fine and warm to hot.

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The wind along the coast will be light to moderate southerly to south-westerly becoming fresh to strong north of Cape Columbine by the afternoon.

The expected UVB sunburn index: Very High

8. WESTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Morning fog patches in the morning, otherwise fine and warm, but hot in places over the interior.

The wind along the coast will be light north easterly, becoming moderate south westerly in the west by late morning, spreading eastwards.

9. EASTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Morning fog patches south of the escarpment, otherwise fine and warm, but partly cloudy in the north.

The wind along the coast will be Light north easterly, but moderate to fresh during the afternoon.

10. KWAZULU-NATAL:

Morning fog patches over the interior otherwise partly cloudy and warm but cloudy in the north.

The wind along the coast will be moderate to fresh easterly to north-easterly becoming strong south of Richards Bay in the afternoon.
